

Orion's Social Distancing Policy

Orion auditors will comply with COVID-19 prevention restrictions communicated to them by our clients. Requirements should be communicated directly to the auditor in enough time that any special equipment can be obtained. All auditors will be prepared for, and will comply with, the following guidance from the state of Colorado:

- **Auditors will wear a mask during the audit, unless there is a minimum distance of 6 feet between people AND the client does not request the auditors to wear a mask. Auditors will need a location to eat and drink where they can safely remove their mask.**
- **Auditors will not attempt to enter any facility when diagnosed with or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.**
- **Auditors will not attempt to enter any facility if they know they have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.**
- **If requested, auditors will consent to having their temperature taken prior to entry into a client's facility.**
- **Auditors will adhere to the client's policies regarding the maximum number of people gathered together, and will not require meetings that exceed this number.**
- **Auditors will not require unnecessary travel for client personnel, and will allow personnel to be audited via remote means to the extent possible.**
